OLYMPIC GOLD MEDALLIST COMES TO PRESTONS PS

Today, the staff parents and students had the priviledge of meeting and listening to Sandra Morgan, Australia's youngest Olympic Gold Medallist at our first ever Sport Presentatioon Day. Sandra won her gold medal at the Melbourne Olympics in 1956, and broke the World record as part of the Women's 4x100m relay team. What made this achievement even more remarkable, was that she did it at the tender age of just 14.

Sandra shared with the students and community some of her Olympic and competitive experiences, and the many hurdles that she faced on her way to achieving this incredible feat. She talked about the resilliance that she required in order to ignore the negative things that were printed in the media at the time (regarding her age and weight) and how her determination and self belief was a key in helping her achive success.

It was such a priviledge to hear her spek today, and I'm sure that everyone got a great deal out of her shared experiences. On behalf of the entire school community, I would like to extend our thanks to Mrs Morgan (nee Beavis) for taking the time to come to our wonderful school and share her story.
