If your child is **not** returning to Prestons Public School in 2017 it is requested that you notify the office in writing advising which school your child will be transferring to.


If your child will not be starting back at school on the 30<sup>th</sup> of January 2017 due to an extended holiday, please notify the office with the expected return date.
